



PhD in cell biology and virology in Strasbourg

A 3-year PhD position is available at the Institute of Viral and Liver Diseases – INSERM U1110 (University of Strasbourg) in the team “Membrane Dynamics & Viruses” under the supervision of Dr. Gaudin and in collaboration with Dr. Baumert.

The team is interested in various aspects of intracellular trafficking pathways and their subversion by viral pathogens. With the objective of tackling current paradigms in the fields of virology and cell biology, the proposed project will focus on characterizing viral entry of flaviviruses using state-of-the-art techniques including Crispr-Cas9 and live cell imaging of viral infection. This multidisciplinary project represents a great opportunity for young students to mature into experienced researchers.

The starting date should be no later than December 2016. The institute is located on the campus of Strasbourg University medical school and offers an internationally renowned research environment with direct access to modern infrastructures.

You hold a master degree in biological sciences with important knowledge in virology, molecular and cell biology. You are curious, motivated and have a problem-solving mindset. The applicant is expected to speak English, while French is not a prerequisite.
