## Scope

Hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) is the fifth-most common cancer with rising incidences and it is the second-most deadly cancer world-wide. In the majority of cases HCC represents a complication of chronic liver disease and develops in livers with prevalent cirrhosis caused by chronic hepatitis, alcohol abuse or non-alcoholic steato-hepatitis (NASH). The high mortality in HCC patients is mainly caused by the currently limited treatment options. A multidisciplinary approach including, functional genomics, bioinformatics, animal and clinical models, is applied to thoroughly understand and to model fundamental processes of liver pathophysiology.
